Further she continued as Senior Resident in prestigious SCB Medical College, Cuttack, Odisha.

She was instrumental in establishing the Immunization clinic, Anti Rabies Vaccination Centre in the OPD complex of AIIMS Bhubaneswar. She was involved actively in developing only one yellow fever vaccination centre of Odisha in AIIMS Bhubaneswar. She is the nodal officer for Yellow fever vaccination centre, immunization clinic and COVID 19 vaccination centre of AIIMS Bhubaneswar. She established first Travel Health Clinic in Institute of National importance in AIIMS Bhubaneswar.

After completion of MD, she joined in State Health Services under Deptt. of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of Odisha. She has worked in remote Tribal and Mao affected districts of Odisha and dedicated herself for providing health services to the poor and needy.
